24 pack or larger

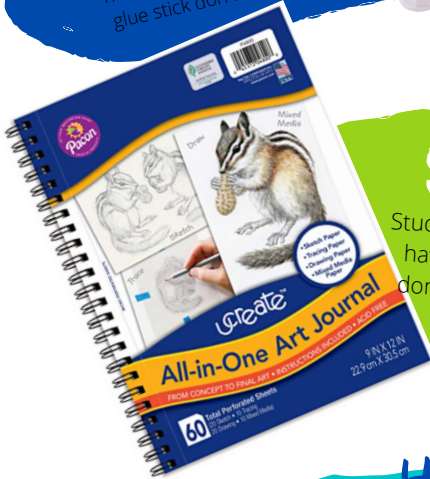
**Crayola Washable Super Tip**
